ATTIRE

Attitudes towards dress are relaxed in Qatar, though visitors are expected to show respect for local culture by avoiding excessively revealing clothing in public places. In malls, it is appropriate to cover the shoulders and wear clothing over the knee.

CASH

All shops are required to provide electronic payment services and cash is not required for most transactions. It is worth taking out cash to haggle for a bargain at Souq Waqif and the traditional markets.



TRANSPORT

One of the easiest ways to get around Qatar comfortably and efficiently is on Doha Metro. The modern system uses driverless trains and links the majority of the country's stadiums and top tourism attractions.



SAFETY
